
What else is your Saint Thomas church about? It is about you. It is about us. It is about future generations. It is about proclaiming Christ in our Midst.

WHO IS A STEWARD?

Definition: Greek: oikonomos; "Manager or overseer"

A steward is a manager or overseer; one with a very special calling. We are all stewards. God has made us managers over all His business here below. We read in Luke 12:42,

"And the Lord said, Who then is that faithful and wise steward, whom his lord shall make ruler over his household, to give them their portion of meat in due season?"

Paul states:

"Let a man so account of us, as of the ministers of Christ." 1 Cor. 4-1
